## **Trekanten Tree Nursery**

- Tree nursery for millions of small trees for forest planting



# Kalmar Cemetery

- Big cemetery with both formal, park-like and natural areas
- Church, chapels and a crematorium are on the premises







## Ängsbackens Nursery

- Family owned nursery with all kinds of plants
- Landscaping services
- Own café with home baked pastries
- Small cut flower production



# Capellagården

- School for design work with courses in furniture, textiles, ceramics, building care and gardening
- Organic nursery with garden shop







## Ölands Alvaret

- Unique cultural area
- Plants specialised to the dry limestone ground
- Since 2000 the agricultural landscape has been on the UNESCO World Heritage List as one of the world's most unique places



# Solliden Royal Park

- Big park with different areas
- Summer residence of the Swedish Royal Family (they do reside in that palace, high security)
- When the flag is hoisted the king is on the premises







## **Halltorps Hage**

- Nature reserve with massive old trees
- Home to many rare organisms
- Sole location in the north where the great Capricorn beetle can live



# Södra Cell Mönsterås

- What you can make out of trees: paper pulp, biomethanol, biodiesel, timber
- On the side: green electricity, district heating







## **Axelssons i Aby**

- Producer of potatoes and strawberries
- Farm shop for locally produced goods
- Pick your own strawberries, raspberries and blackberries



## Stensjö by

- Straight out of a Astrid Lindgren book!
- cultural reserve that is being farmed and managed in the traditional way
- vegetable and fruit garden that is restored to its historic origin







## Tålebo Garden

- 4000m<sup>2</sup> private garden in development
- Different zones including woodland, rock garden, north American trees



# Mönsterås Kommun

- Local biodiversity project
- Sand/gravel/stone beds to create important environments for pollinating insects
